

## Media Critique-- Fahrenheit 451

### Expectations:

- **Introduce** the film to readers. What subject does it cover? Give a brief plot description and set it in its time and place. What issues does it raise? What do you see as the main purpose of the film? What seems to be the target audience?
- **Identify** the major theme(s)/ messages and what you think the film says about that/those themes.
- **Evaluate** the film for quality, depending on which criteria you decide matter the most in this case: the story, acting, cinematography, music, plot in comparison to the book etc.
- **Relate** the film to class discussions, readings, and experiences. Directly relate to the book. Feel free to make it somewhat personal.
- **Summarize** your overall statement briefly emphasizing the main point you want to make about the film & its effectiveness in its message.
